



Dog Obedience Class

- Dogs must be at least 4 months old
- Owners must be at least 12 years old or with an adult
- Dogs must be on a six-foot leash (no choke chains please)
- Students must bring their dog's vaccination records to the first class
- Owners must clean-up after their dog

There is no "magic wand" in training a dog. Patience, practice and praise go a long way. A happy dog has a purpose and has guidelines. This is accomplished through obedience and socializing.

All pack animals have a pecking order. It is the job of the owner to establish this pecking order. If not, a dog will intuitively seek the "top-dog" position.
